Market Alerts

Transition – The springtime movement of major growing regions, from Yuma AZ northward to Central California, is underway. “Transition,” as this is called, is a time of year when certain crops are more susceptible to supply disruptions, higher pricing, and quality issues.

Avocados – Supplies have tightened up quickly due to a harvest slowdown among Mexican growers. California’s crop is forecasted to be 50% of last year’s volume, making any import shortage more extreme. Pricing is much higher than in prior weeks, and fully ripened fruit may be less available.

Bell Peppers – Supplies of **Green and Colored Bells** have tightened up again, due to light harvest and field transition in Florida and Mexico’s growing regions. Quality is good, but pricing is higher than normal. **Choice-Grade Green Bells** are the best value.

Celery – Pricing remains very high on both bulk and pre-cut **Celery**, with continued short supplies out of Yuma and California. Quality is fair to good.

Cauliflower- Supplies of Heads and Florets are slightly improved, but pricing may be higher than normal, with good to fair quality reported.

Onions: Red and Yellow Onions are in a temporary supply gap for the next few weeks. The Pacific Northwest storage crop is finishing early, and the Texas harvest has yet to ramp up. Pricing may be higher in certain markets, with good to fair quality.

A Peek at Peak Seasons

Melons – Cantaloupe and Honeydew quality is great from all Central American growing regions, with very good sugar levels.

Kale – The final harvest out of Central California is yielding great quality at good prices.

Swiss Chard – Great quality on Green, Red and Rainbow Chard out of California and Mexico.

Chili Peppers – Anaheim, Serrano and Pasilla Peppers are all very good quality.

Strawberries – The best quality in months is reported on all California Strawberries.

Squash – Zucchini Squash has terrific quality and low pricing.

Grapes – Quality is very nice on Red Grapes out of Chile.

Citrus – Late season specialty Citrus is available with great quality reported – Tangerines, Cara Caras and Mandarins.

Asparagus – Be on the lookout for early spring local Asparagus in the Midwest, Northeast and Pacific Northwest.

Weather Update

California: Warmer temperatures across all growing regions with light showers early next week in San Joaquin Valley.

Yuma, AZ: Very windy conditions and warm temperatures.

Mexico: Seasonal temperatures throughout all growing regions.

Florida: Seasonal temperatures and moderate to heavy rain early in the week.
